



Make sure the email includes your name and the "title" of each image being submitted. Neither your name or the image title should be visible on the image itself.

DETAILS

1. This contest is open to the general public.
2. You may submit up to 3 images.
3. You must be the photographer of the images submitted and they should have been taken within the past 3 years.
4. Post editing is acceptable. AI is OK for post editing, however, original image must be camera generated by submitter.

5. Image criteria: JPG format
300 dpi
Color or B&W
Max 2400 x 3000 pixels
Landscape or vertical

AWARDS

The TOP 4 images will receive a book of the images that were submitted, as well as a special awards ceremony at the VFW Post 2391.

In addition, a special group of selected images will be framed and displayed on the walls in the St. Johns County Health and Human Services Building where the Veterans Administration Service Office is located. When this viewing period is over, they will be displayed at the VFW Post for a limited period, and submitted to the National VFW Magazine for publication.

Show Me the Money Card Game *by Post 2391* **1-4 PM Sundays**

The game is open to those 18 years and older. Post membership is not required to play but you must be a member to purchase alcohol.

How does it work?

Show Me the Money is a bingo-type game using playing cards instead of standard bingo cards. Groups of three random playing cards are stapled together to be used in the game.

Players purchase one set of cards for \$1. Players may purchase more than one set of cards. Once all players have purchased the desired number of sets of cards, the game will begin.

20% of the collected funds are donated to the post.

The caller will shuffle a full deck of cards and the dealer will ask those playing if anyone wishes to cut the deck, the dealer will begin calling the cards in their shuffle order beginning with the top card. When a player has all three cards in a stapled group, covered they will call "SHOW ME THE MONEY". The winning cards will be verified and the winner will receive the money collected for that game, less the 20% donated to the post.

When the game is completed the sets of cards will be collected by the caller. The resale will be made for the next game.
